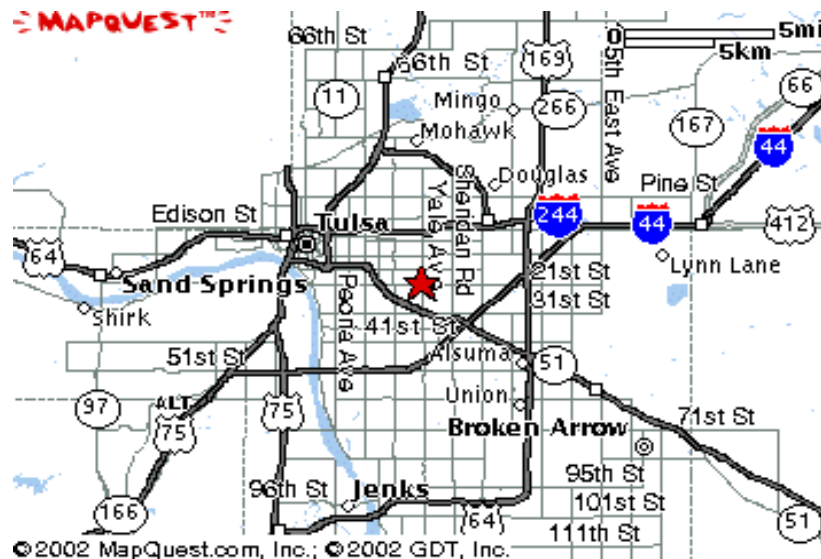
Driving Directions:

From the Hwy 169 (North) – Exit on I-244 – West from Hwy 169. Follow I-244 to the YALE AVE exit and go South. Turn right (west) at 15th street. Turn Left into the fairgrounds approximately ¼ mile. The arena and office will be to your right. Gate 6

From Hwy 75 (North) – Follow Hwy 75 into town and exit at I-244 East. Follow I-244 to YALE AVE exit. Turn right onto Yale. Turn right at 15th Street. Turn left into fairgrounds approx ¼ mile. Arena and office will be to your right. Gate 6

From Hwy 75 (South) – Follow Hwy 75 into town and exit at BROKEN ARROW EXPRESSWAY. Exit on 15TH street. (That is a tight lane and turn when you exit!). Turn right at stop sign and turn right again onto 15th street. Go through stop light and turn RIGHT into fairgrounds approx ¾ mile. Gate 6

From I-44 (east or west). Exit on Yale Avenue. Go NORTH on Yale to 15th street. Turn LEFT onto 15th street. Turn left into fairgrounds approx ¼ mile Gate 6

Due to expansion in the Buckskin Association Show, we are moving to MUSTANG Arena and Explorer Barn for 2008.

TULSA SUMMER CLASSIC

ENTRIES: Entry and stall reservations must be accompanied with a check or money order, payable to the TULSA SUMMER CLASSIC and mailed to Show Secretary, Kelly McFaul. All entries must be made on an official entry blank one owner per entry blank. Every exhibitor, rider, driver, handler, coach and trainer or his agent must sign an entry blank. In the case of a rider, driver or handler under the age of 18, his parent or guardian, or if not available, the trainer must sign an entry blank on the minor's behalf.

Deadline July 7, 2008.

POST ENTRIES: Entries not postmarked by the entry deadline, July 7th, will be subject to a post entry fee of \$25.00 per horse. There is no post entry fee for additional classes for horses entered in the show prior to the deadline. If added classes are not paid for at the time of entry, then a signed check made payable to the show must be deposited with the show secretary.

There will be no payback in Jr. Exhibitor, Equitation, In Hand, Water Glass, Ride-A-Buck or Dressage. Payback will be mailed within thirty (30) days of the close of the show and will be mailed to the owner.

CHAMPIONSHIPS: All Exhibitors are strongly encouraged to show back in the Championship classes. First through third place winners in qualifying classes are required to enter the championship class. Exhibitors must complete the official entry form in the

office for these classes. Winners in Junior Horse classes, Junior Exhibitor classes, Amateur classes are not required to show back in Open Performance Championships but may enter those classes. They will be required to show back in their respective Championships if offered. High Point awards will not be mailed if exhibitor is not present.

STABLING: Stall assignments will be posted at the show office. Stalls will be available at 8:00 a.m. on Wednesday, July 30, at \$70.00 per stall. Stalls will be available for early arrival for an additional fee of \$15.00 per stall per day. If you plan to arrive on Monday or Tuesday, you must mark your Entry Form and include fees. Stalls will not be available prior to Monday, 5:00 PM. The show will try to honor requests to be stalled with another exhibitor, but only if the request is made by both parties. Stalls are 10x10 with full stall doors. You MUST arrange with fairgrounds if staying over Sunday night. Stall flooring is asphalt.

BEDDING/FEED: Tulsa Expo Square requires all feed and bedding, other than what the exhibitor supplies, to be purchased from Pete's Feed on Expo Square. Flooring for all stalls is **asphalt**. Early arrivals should arrange with Pete's Feed to assure bedding is available for their arrival time. Pre-Order form is included. Additional information is available on www.morganhorseok.org.

CAMPERS, TRAILERS AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLES: Entrance is at Gate 5 from 15th Street. Showers and restroom facilities are located within the secured campground area. An attendant will collect the fees and give you a receipt. *Reservations ARE accepted and encouraged.* 30 Amp Service is \$28/night and 50 Amp service is \$30/night. REFUNDS: If Management is notified prior to the entry deadline, all entry and stall fees will be refunded less the office fee. After that date, entry fees only will be refunded if a veterinarian certificate is presented. Refunds will be mailed within thirty (30) days after the close of the show.

RESPONSIBILITY: All exhibitors in the horse show will be under the control and direction of the Show Management and Show Management will not be responsible for loss, injury or damage to horses exhibited or for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, stolen or in any way damaged. Please report lost/stolen articles to the Show Manager. Please be careful to secure all property, including tack stalls and trailers. It is recommended that a lock be provided for any loose equipment on your trailer while parking on the fairgrounds.

Persons engaged in livestock activities at Tulsa Expo Square assume all risks associated with and inherent in the participation of such activities. Tulsa Expo Square and/or the Morgan Horse Association of Oklahoma shall not be responsible in any manner for injuries and/or damages, either seen or unforeseen, sustained by any person engaged in livestock activities on said premises as provided for under "Oklahoma Law. See, "Oklahoma Livestock Activities Liability Limitation Act" 17 O.S. 50.1, et. Seq..

WARM-UP AREAS: Warm-Up, adjacent to Arena, is for the use of the exhibitors during all sessions. No longing or whips will be allowed during any performance session. During competition on Thursday, all competitors will be allowed in the warm-up areas but consideration to the dressage riders will be required. Show Manager reserves the right to limit the use of the warm up area to the entrants in the next class when congestion occurs. Additional warm up area is available throughout the show in the outdoor arena.


HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: The State of Oklahoma requires an official health certificate for ALL out of state horses issued within thirty (30) days. ALL HORSES must have a current negative Coggins test dated within twelve (12) months.

PARKING/UNLOADING: Temporary parking along barns is allowed only for a reasonable time for move-in or move-out. All trailer parking will be to the North of the arena. **Trailers must not be parked in the first 3 rows. These are reserved for passenger cars.** Please lock your vehicles at all times and be prepared to secure your trailer.

NO SMOKING: Tulsa Expo Square is a smoke free facility. This includes; the Exhibit Hall, Arena and Horse Barn. No smoking is allowed inside the buildings. Designated smoking sections are stationed outside the facilities.

PETS: No dogs shall be allowed into the facility, except for those certified to assist the physically challenged. Only dogs on leashes shall be allowed in the exercise and outdoor barn areas.

NO SCOOTERS, SKATEBOARDS, BICYCLES OR ROLLER BLADES ALLOWED WITHIN THE EQUINE FACILITIES. NO MOTORIZED VEHICLES ALLOWED INSIDE THE BARNS OR IN THE AISLEWAYS.

Introductory Level and Training Level Tests 1, 2 & 3 will be ridden in the small (20 meter x 40 meter) arena if entries warrant. High Point awards will be awarded based on the average of the two highest scores for a Horse/Rider combination except for Introductory where teams must compete in both tests and scores will be averaged. The Morgan Dressage High Point award is the highest average of a Morgan horse/rider combination who has competed in at least 3 tests. Youth competitors may chose to compete in the Youth class or the Open class. Cross entering will be allowed but a test will only be ridden once.
